



17.4.3 - Does your university as body have dedicated outreach educational activities for the wider community, which could include alumni, local residents, displaced people?

Since 2021, Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University has provided a total of 80 courses and workshops for the community to participate in various community activities. Among them, the national workshop on environmental awareness and the challenges of climate change, which took place in cooperation with the departments of research and development, relations and media in the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, in the presence of the Undersecretary for Scientific Research Affairs, the Director General of the Research and Development Department, the Director of the Private University Education Department, and the representative of the Studies, Planning and Follow-up Department. Around 500 persons participated in this event, including university council committees, specialists, academics, support staff, members of the general public, university entrepreneurs, alumni, and the national university network. The workshop proceedings have also been transmitted online on Zoom, Facebook and other platforms. Some examples of the conducted activities are shown below:
