



3.3.2 - Does your university as a body deliver outreach programmes and projects in the local community (which can include student volunteering programmes) to improve or promote health & wellbeing including hygiene, nutrition, family planning, sports, exercise, aging well, and other health and wellbeing related topics?

Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University offers outreach programs and projects in the community to enhance or promote health and wellbeing. These initiatives frequently involve student volunteers. Health, nutrition, family planning, exercise, training, sports, ageing, and other themes pertaining to health and wellbeing are among the project topics. Some examples of these conducted outreach programs and projects are listed below:

1. Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University has agreed to sponsor Social Networking Day, an annual service program for students, employees, and professors to leave the office and have a noticeable effect with our community partners, as part of Nursing and Health Innovation's dedication to community involvement. To link the university to health solutions through volunteer opportunities in the neighborhood, a social networking day was developed. In addition to giving professors and staff meaningful volunteer opportunities, Social Networking Day offers groups of people a way to work together in a special setting that encourages cooperation and friendship.
2. Al-Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University has held many sporting events to help build a university sports generation with upright morals and upright behavior, refining the energies and talents of students and employing these energies in what is beneficial and fruitful. For example, Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University sponsored a cheerleading match between former international players and the children of the Iraqi Center for Creativity. The match took place as part of the sporting events and activities held by the Department of English at the Faculty of Arts, in the presence of the





Scientific Assistant to the President of the University, Dr. Jamal Hajj Yassin. Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University also organized the University Martyr Football Championship, which will last for the period from 16-20/4/2022. The activities of the tournament were launched in honor of the families of the martyrs, from the President of the University's Board of Directors, Mr. Hussein Baraka Al-Shami.

3. Al-Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University established a university health committee to enhance university health education and offer a superior learning environment. The committee develops university environmental sewage management and medical services, works with pertinent agencies and groups to jointly advance university sewage, and aspires to the idea that "health includes overall fitness, psychological health, excellent social adaptability, and good moral health."
