



3.3.4 - Does your university as a body provide students access to sexual and reproductive health-care services including information and education services?

Every academic year, Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University organizes a number of gender education programs and offers students healthcare services related to sexual and reproductive health. The subjects covered comprise sexual education, sexual bullying protection, and emotional education. The activities are presented as lectures and seminars. Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University instructs students to reflect on the relationship between others and themselves through these activities in order to create a welcoming campus atmosphere. Students are taught to investigate the broad range of gender-related topics. Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University actively promotes sexual activities and sexual education as medical care in order to incorporate resources for AIDS prevention education and sexual education, protect students from getting HIV, and increase understanding of on-campus sex education and AIDS prevention among faculty and students.
