



3.3.5 - Does your university as a body provide students and staff with access to mental health support?

For a long time, Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University has worked to give students, teachers, and staff access to free mental health support. In addition to setting up a division for student educational and psychological counseling. The division aims to establish referral and cooperate partnerships with community organizations while integrating professional resources for educational and psychological treatment (including hospitals, courts, and social and political units). For students, professors, staff, and members of the community, the university also offers educational and psychological counseling services, as well as hands-on training and supervision by professional psychologists. In addition to opening the Department of Clinical Psychology, which accepts graduates of high school students with its scientific and literary branches. The department has a group of qualified professors who have experience in diagnosing and understanding mental, emotional and behavioral problems that affect patients, ranging from young children to the elderly.
