



4.3.4 - Does your university as a body undertake educational outreach activities (e.g. tailored lectures or demonstrations) beyond campus, e.g. in local schools, in the community, including voluntary student-run schemes?

Annually, Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University employees and students plan several events that take place away from the campus. The primary activities carried out by Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq Academic staff and students include local and regional school visits. Every year, representatives from Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University go to nearby and regional schools to show the students there how the university's many colleges and specialties work.

We encourage students to individually develop various sorts of educational and learning events and establish off-campus service teams, in addition to the conducted workshops in various local schools or community groups arranged by our staff. In order to arrange science education experimental camps or off-campus service activities, they can visit nearby schools and rural primary and secondary schools. They can also deliver learning materials from Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University to nearby primary and secondary schools and organizations. Some of conducted outreach activities are described below:

- 1. With the help of two volunteer teams made up of university students and staff, community and campus service learning courses were planned to implement advocacy sessions for traffic safety, anti-drug awareness, and capability in elementary schools.
- 2. Organizing a first aid training session named "Technique in transferring the injured BLS" that was organized by the Department of Medical Laboratory Techniques at Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University, Al-Najaf Branch, in association with the Volunteer National Paramedic Team. First







aid techniques and the most crucial paramedic duties in a variety of injury scenarios as well as the manner of transporting and rescuing the injured were put into practice in a number of practical applications. Several middle school and vocational education students took part in the first aid operation's application utilizing real people and medical supplies.

- 3. The College of Law visits the Higher Institute for Security and Administrative Development. On Tuesday, 28/12/2021, the College of Law at Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University organized a scientific visit that included students of the fourth stage of the Higher Institute for Security and Administrative Development. The visit was supervised by the Assistant Dean of the College of Law for Scientific Affairs and a number of professors, who were received by the Institute's Assistant Dean. The students were briefed on the methods of examining forensic evidence, the virtual and confirmatory DNA laboratory, the Department of Graduate Studies, the Library, the Information Technology Department, and the Language Department. The two parties agreed to hold several seminars at the university and at the institute as well.
- 4. About 25 on-campus and community service courses at Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University conduct annual projects including preserving wetlands, maintaining beaches and green spaces, promoting energy efficiency, and raising money for needy families and orphanages.
