



4.3.5 - Does your university as a body have a policy that ensures that access to these activities is accessible to all, regardless of ethnicity, religion, disability, immigration status or gender?

With no distinctions made based on gender, immigrant status, color, or religion, Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University hosts a variety of events and classes. The university has established a number of relevant and important laws and policies to protect students' rights to education in order to guarantee that students who are relatively less advantaged, such as those who are financially disadvantaged, and students of different genders, have an equal opportunity to study peacefully.

1. An office for students with low incomes seeking university scholarships was created by Imam Ja'afar Al-Sadiq University. Without altering any of the aforementioned situations, several groups of individuals gain from these grants. Among the groups that benefit from these grants are, but are not limited to:

- Low income people.
- The three most accomplished students in their academic fields (Talented Students).
- Those with unique familial circumstances.
- Those who are physically disabled.
- People who have mental illnesses.

2. The university constantly attempts to support faculty efforts to organize events in line with their domains of expertise and supports student initiatives to assist underprivileged groups.

3. Without making any distinctions based on race, religion, or sect, the university aims to promote student contests in high school and middle





school by offering financial aid and full university scholarships to the winning students.

4. Together with the Department of Medical Laboratory Techniques, the university aims to provide free laboratory testing for all students.
